All horses and riders must be registered c/o IPZV ("Zentralregister"). Exception the tests 40 up to 45.

Late fee payments and changes: Up to two hours before qualifying test for double the fee per test for horse/rider. In case of a horse's or rider's no-show, only their paddock fee will be reimbursed.

Clothing: Has to comply with the rules from the IPO / FIPO. Helmet duty.

Vaccinations: All horses entered into competition must be vaccinated according to the IPZV regulations and must originate from a healthy stock. The equine pass and/or vaccination pass is to be submitted at the registration office upon arrival. No starting permit will be granted for incomplete vaccination identifications.

* Adults and Young Riders (YR) compete together in preliminaries and will have separate finals.

Rider tests and dressage will be in the riding hall (16 x 30m). The organizer subjects to alteration. The organizer can combine tests of the different classes / engine power classes, to chop and to coat tests by low attendance.

Liability:

Participation in the event and the accommodation of horses at own risk. The horses indicated must have sufficient liability insurance. The riders and horse owners have unlimited liability according to § 833. During the entire event the rider / owner remains the animal caregiver in the sense of §834 German Civil Code (BGB).

❖ skill course

A combination of tests which will have to be performed while either riding the horse or leading it (by its headcollar) through the circuit which contains 5 exercises, e.g. slalom and a variety of obstacles.

❖ Eichenhof Triathlon (starting at 14 years of age)

1. Task portion: The rider must run 1000 m (a little Westhofround),
2. Task portion: "rubber boot throwing qualifying test",
3. Task portion: Agility in tölt: 1 lap of any tempo tölt (style, gating, seat and influence), then a gait lap with a filled beer glass or water glass. After a lap is completed, it is measured how much water is still in the glass.

❖ Eichenhof Triathlon (to 14 years of age)

1. Task portion: The rider must run 2000 m (a big Westhofround),
2. Task portion: "rubber boot throwing qualifying test",
3. Task portion: Agility in tölt: 1 lap of any tempo tölt (style, gating, seat and influence), then a gait lap with a filled beer glass or water glass. After a lap is completed, it is measured how much water is still in the glass.

❖ Evening event:
